Jennifer Flores	As a staff member, requesting every board meeting has a zoom meeting every single month and have knowledge and a say. We want to know first hand and not hear from someone else. Since covid, we know zooms are quite available.

	Safety- As a teacher and responsible party, concerned about safety and things that have transpired past few days causing our school to close. Asynchronous learning will happen Friday. We don't know why. I'm afraid for Joselyn's family, our students, and our school.
	There is security full time available all the time at my children's school. If a situation happens here like it did at my child's son last week who will provide protection.
	Arslan: you deserve an explanation
	Nalcaci: 2 senior kids involved in a fight last Friday. Discipline committee decided to suspend the kids for several days. Today came to our attention that there would be a fight. APD officer came and did an investigation and met with several of the kids and shared the rumors and information. He concluded the probability basis. To be safe we decided to call tomorrow for remote learning. We communicated with APS and they approved our decision for tomorrow. After that the message was sent to the community via text, email and we

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	communicated with staff members.
	Arslan: We will discuss this again. Alright thank you.
Jeselyn Arriaga	Myself and my father are here to share some serious safety concerns. My father asked me to speak. Son, Joshua was assaulted. HIt first. Hold other student. 2 other friends of the aggressor pulled him off to continue. No supervision. Noone there to help. No one was trained. Fight broken up by a lotus parent. Not one person asked the aggressor to stay and explain what happened. Lotus kids posting all over social media. Joshua spent the night in the ER. Hernandez told him to not bring him back to the school for the soccer game due to the treat made. The treat leaves the whole family in danger. Admin can't tell them nothing. The threat is against us. We are treated like we are the other families. You are aware of this threat and we are not. We hold you personally responsible. What are you doing to ensure his safety, our safety. Lotus has to help. We are praying for our safety.
	Arslan: Both issues are related? yes We need to talk about possible security interventions. This has been an ongoing issue on campus. We have discussed to have an onsite personal. It is time to discuss this matter seriously. We need on campus security watching over the issues. I'm not blaming the people but somewhere on the campus or out in the parking lot. Nalcaci: I need to work on that and get quotes. It can be armed/unarmed. Get a quote from a security company or we can consider hiring our own. A retired police officer. We did make contact with APD. \$85 per hour and minimum day is 4 hours.

From the public comment at the beginning of the meeting.

We initially didn't mention about it being a gun threat to not cause panic. For the safety of our staff members we decided to go remote. We came together several times with our admin team before we finalized our decision.

Kara: found out someone in the hallway started the rumor. We found the base.

Nalcaci: With attendance and the impact of the school day we decided to go remote.

For the incident that happened, it happened during dismissal time. 323p

Some parents delay to pick up kids that is the parents fault not the students. It is unsafe to have the students into the

parking lot. I believe the safety level of our campus is acceptable. Things happen at campuses and are unexpected. Let me work on options, and look at the cost, and hopefully we can discuss at the next board meetings.

Angela: (clarifying)

Kavi: How about additional security, mentioning metal detectors.

Nalcaci: I'm against those. They are problematic. I don't think we are there to install metal detectors. They are problematic to use.

Arslan: We had concerns with students passing through detectors.

Angela: and the flow as well. But maybe we can revisit that.

Kavi: How about CCTV...is someone watching them all the time.

Nasir: no, but we have 24 hours recording.

Kavi: at my company we had someone watching all the time.

Nasir: The only place to put a detector is in one hallway... other places are too tight. They also

suggested to have a guard next to each detector (trained personal).

Underwood: Maybe the wand. SRO watching cams but at arrival/dismissal/lunch he was present.

Listening to the news in Georgia, maybe look at a panic button. Not having to wait on the front office or admin. It would be nice where they could communicated silently. Depending how many times you tapped it sent out EMS, Fire Department, PD etc.

Angela: Maybe it is a code

Underwood: If the state of Georgia has it, maybe we can look at that.

Nasir: We have panic buttons for staff. We have capability we need to purchase and program those.

Underwood: I think those are nice for students harm self or others.

Nasir: Communicating classroom by classroom. (1-1 conversation with admin).

Flores: Her family is not safe and they don't know what they are safe from. Her brother hasn't left home since Friday. I don't

know what to say to her when I say goodbye tonight. I don't want a casualty. Her father is going to homeschool brother. Think deep think hard about their family. They don't know why. Don't think just about future plans. You have security coming, you closed school. . . This boy knows where they live. We are scared for her. We have children and families too.

Arslan: It is a rumor.
There is no evidence. But to be on the safe side we shut down school for tomorrow. We are going to deep dive to have someone on site.

Angela: We are taking in everything into account with APD.

Kara: We know who's backpack to check. We have a plan in place. We talked with APD and APS. Bring him to my office first and we go to the first class first. The other side is covered.

Arslan: We will secure a meeting to discuss.

Nalcaci: Is it full day?

Kara: I will follow up. If someone says they can come we can use private security.

	Nalcaci: We have so many new students and families. It takes time to learn them and follow discipline guidelines. Dean-Ms. Hernandez is working pretty well. We will post behaviorist position. Don't have many behavior issues in Elementary but we still decided to hire. Kara: We were also approved for another paraeducator. We don't want teachers to have duties.
