We understand that recent discussions about immigration enforcement may have caused concern for some families. Please know that **our school remains a safe and welcoming place for all students and families**. At LSE, we take pride in serving a diverse community, and our focus continues to be on providing the best learning environment for your children.

At this time, we have **no reason to believe** that immigration officials will visit our school buildings. However, if such a situation arises, please be assured that we are **prepared to handle it safely, calmly, and appropriately**.

**If immigration officers come to our school:**

- School leaders will follow clear procedures to protect students and their information.
- We will contact legal counsel and follow the proper legal steps before sharing any information.
- Immigration officers are only allowed in the school building if they present a judicial warrant.
- Parents and guardians will be informed if any requests are made regarding their child.
- LSE staff do not know and do not request students' immigration status.
